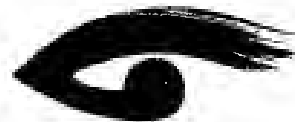

SUMMARY OF THE REASONS FOR DECISION:

The magazine *3-Way Orgasms # 3* is classified as:

Objectionable except if the availability of the publication is restricted to persons who have attained the age of 18 years.

The magazine consists of colour photographs with minimal text. The photographs are separated into two scenarios, one taking place in a restaurant, the other in a dentist's clinic. The photographs explicitly depict group sexual activities including fellatio, cunnilingus, masturbation, and anal and vaginal intercourse. Some of the magazine's depictions are considered dehumanising owing to the close focus placed upon the participants' genitalia. These are mitigated by the majority of the photographs which focus upon the participants' bodies and faces. However, owing to the dehumanising nature of some of the photographs and the explicit sexual nature of the photographs, the magazine is likely to be injurious to public good unless restricted to an adult audience.
